

* Robert Juris & Associates in conjunction with a team of consultants started this project by first analyzing a creating a five year Master Capital Improvement Plan for the 70 year old Park District. This analysis involved inspecting all park buildings and facilities for code compliance, accessibility issues, maintenance items, and community needs. The focal point of the project involved doing an addition, remodeling, and restoration to the main building originally built in 1938 as a WPA project in a limestone and Tudor style. The main building contains the bathhouse, two multi-purpose rooms, offices, meeting spaces, and bathrooms which were remodeled and brought up to current building and accessibility standards. As part of our study it was found that there was need for community gathering spaces of varying sizes and uses. The addition was designed to tie seamlessly into the existing building and create a new focal entry to the building, with a new 2-story lobby, registration office, board room, and elevator, In addition, the 3rd floor was remodeling to create a new multipurpose room, and the rear pool veranda was remodeled and extended with stairs connecting it to the pool deck.



This 6,000 square-foot building was designed to fit into a community of single family and multi-family residences, and provide easy access for the residents of the neighborhood. It is staffed and operated by the Addison Police Department and the Addison Community Switchboard. The front side of the building provides spaces for after school programs, public meetings and adult education classes and consists of a divisible multi-purpose room, computer lab, offices, and a kitchenette. The Switchboard is located in the rear portion of the building and provides donated food and clothes to residents of the community that are in need.




* Robert Juris & Associates Architects, Ltd. has worked with the Addison Park District to determine the feasibility of acquiring the shuttered Driscoll Catholic High School from the Diocese of Joliet for use as a new Recreation Center. Our firm worked with W-T Engineering to analyze the existing conditions of the buildings and prepare recommendations with cost estimates for how the building could be modified to meet the Park District's needs. It was determined that the 32,000 SF classroom wing and 9,000 SF Sister's Convent building were not needed and could be removed to give the building a new main entry that would face the street while allowing for the installation of a new driveway and soccer field. In the remaining 45,000 SF, the gymnasium and locker rooms would be updated to meet the new their new needs, the commons would provide space for a fitness room, the music room would be converted for gymnastics, the chapel would be remodeled to a multi-purpose room, the kitchen would be used for concessions, and the theater could remain as-is or be remodeled as a youth indoor soccer facility. Finally, the 9,000 SF Brother's Residence would be completely remodeled for the use as a new day care facility to be run by the Park District.



Recommendations were made for both facility locations recommendations as to consolidation, additions and remodeling were considered.

We prepared design development drawings for both facilities, as well as an estimate of probable construction costs. We also evaluated making the Worth facility handicapped accessible.
