**A RESOLUTION TO WAIVE THE BID PROCESS AND APPROVE
A PROPOSAL FROM GEORGE'S LANDSCAPING, INC.
FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF MEADOWDALE PARK**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/8-9-1 and the provisions of Chapter 36.43(C) of the Village Code of Ordinances, the Village of Romeoville may by a vote of 2/3 of its Trustees then holding office, waive the otherwise applicable requirements for public bidding, whether for labor, services or work, the construction of public works or improvements, or the purchase, lease or sale of personal property, materials, equipment or supplies; and

WHEREAS, The Village of Romeoville ("Village") has heretofore reviewed proposals for general contractual services from George's Landscaping, Inc. (a.k.a. GLI) for the development of Meadowdale Park and is attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, The Village desires to accept the proposal for \$131,120 with George's Landscaping, Inc. for said general contractual services; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Romeoville is an Illinois home rule municipal corporation under the 1970 Illinois Constitution; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that:

SECTION 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2. Waiver of Public Bid Requirements: That pursuant to the provisions of 65 ILCS 5/8-9-1 and the provisions of Chapter 36.43(C) of the Village Code of Ordinances, the Village of Romeoville, by a two-thirds vote of its Corporate Authorities, hereby waives the public bidding procedures applicable to the provision for general contractual services for the development of Meadowdale Park, and further that the Village President and Village Clerk are hereby respectively authorized to accept and execute a proposal from George's Landscaping, Inc. for general contractual services for the development of Meadowdale Park and to execute any further contractual documents necessary to effectuate the same consistent with and in substantially the form attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

SECTION 3. That the various provisions of this Resolution are to be considered severable and if any part or portion of this Resolution shall be held invalid by any Court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. All prior Resolutions and Resolutions, or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with this Resolution are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

SECTION 5. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
