A Resolution Awarding the Contract for the Drilling of Well 14 to Water Well Solutions of Elburn, Illinois. Romeoville, Illinois

Whereas, the Village of Romeoville (“The Village”) is a municipality in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and

Whereas, the Village of Romeoville has determined that there is a need to add additional potable water supply to its system and has worked with other governmental agencies to determine that the northern edge of Romeoville (in the Marquette Zone) is an appropriate location for a deep well; and

Whereas, Village Staff accepted formal bids from two (2) contractors to perform construction related services for this project; and,

Whereas, Village Staff (along with Strand Engineering) reviewed the bids and rejected the lowest bidder (Layne Christensen Company) due to their inclusion of conditions and exceptions taken to/from the Bid Document requirements; and,

Whereas, Village Staff recommends the Village Board formally award the contract to Water Well Solutions in the amount of \$1,160,213.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: ACCEPTANCE AND AWARD OF CONTRACT: The Village of Romeoville hereby awards the contract to Water Well Solutions in the amount of \$1,160,213.00.

Section 2: The Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.

Section 3: RECITALS: The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
