A Resolution for the Participation in the State Bid Contract for the Supplying of Bulk Road Salt for the 2018/2019 Fiscal Year

Whereas, the Village of Romeoville ("The Village") is a municipality in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and,

Whereas, the expenditures for the purchasing of bulk road salt are allocated in the Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Budget; and,

Whereas, Village staff recommends the Village participate in the State Bid Contract for the purchase of bulk road salt from Cargill Inc. at the unit price of \$52.35 per ton, up to an amount not to exceed \$500,000; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1:** <u>Incorporation of Recitals</u>: The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as if fully set forth herein.
- **Section 2:** Participation in Contract: The Village of Romeoville participates in the State Bid Contract for the purchase of bulk road salt from Cargill Inc. at the unit price of \$52.35 per ton, up to an amount not to exceed \$500,000.
- **Section 3:** Repealer: All other Ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Village of Romeoville that are inconsistent with this ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.
- **Section 4:** <u>Severability:</u> In the event any word, phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, provision, or section of this Resolution or any portion thereof shall be held to be unconstitutional, unenforceable, or void, the same shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any remaining words, phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, or sections thereof.
- **Section 5:** Effective Date: The resolution shall take effect after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
