A Resolution Amending a Contract and Certain Lease Documents - Martin Whalen Office Solutions and US Bank

Whereas, the Village of Romeoville ("The Village") is a municipality in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and,

Whereas, the Village of Romeoville ("The Village") has heretofore reviewed the Equipment Lease Agreement and Coverage Maintenance Agreement from Martin Whalen Office Solutions, Inc.; and,

Whereas, the copy equipment from Martin Whalen Office Solutions, Inc. will provide the Village with the added features and functionality it desires; and,

Whereas, to permit prompt commencement and installation of the aforementioned copy equipment, the Village must execute an amended lease with US Bank and authorize other purchase documents with Martin Whalen Office Solutions, Inc. for various copier solutions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

Section 2.
