**RESOLUTION: Waive the Bidding Requirements and Utilize the State Bid Contract for the Purchase of Two Ford F150 and Two Ford F250 Pickup Trucks**

**Whereas,** The Village of Romeoville (“The Village”) is a municipality in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970; and,

**Whereas,** The Village will utilize the State Bid Contract for the purchase of two Ford F150 pickup trucks and two Ford F250 pickup trucks from Morrow Brothers Ford Inc.; and,

**Whereas,** The Village has \$70,000 approved in the FY 19/20 Budget for the purchase of the F150 pickup trucks, and \$80,000 approved for the F250 pickup trucks. The purchase price of the F150 trucks is \$30,965.00 each, for a total amount of \$61,930.00, and the purchase price of the F250 trucks is \$34,750.00, for a total amount of \$69,500.00, which is below the budgeted amounts; and,

**Whereas,** The Village Staff recommends waiving the bidding requirements and utilizing the State Bid Contract for the purchase of two Ford F150 pickup trucks and two Ford F250 pickup trucks; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES FOR THE VILLAGE OF ROMEOVILLE, WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** The Village of Romeoville will waive the bidding requirements and utilize the State Bid Contract for the purchase of two Ford F150 pickup trucks for a total amount of \$61,930.00 and two Ford F250 pickup trucks for a total amount of \$69,500.00.

**Section 2:** The Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form, as provided by law.
